### **Terms and Conditions**

1. The vehicles will not be sold for prices less than the specified Reserve value.
2. The bidders are required to provide their Name, postal address, Telephone number, Aadhar card.
3. The quoted rates shall be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening the bids.
4. The University makes no guaranty, warranty, or representation of any kind as to the fitness of the vehicle for any particular use or purpose, and no claim shall be considered for adjustment.
5. The vehicle is sold to Buyer, and Buyer accepts the vehicle, "as is, where is."
6. The bid security of successful bidder shall be retained by the university and adjusted in the amount receivable and for the rest it shall be returned in two weeks time on demand.
7. The successful bidder shall pay 25% of the amount within 24 hours on receipt of order and the remaining 75% in a period of 5 working days.
8. On receipt of payment the University issues a certificate/order duly signed confirming the sale of the vehicle in buyer's favour.
9. On receipt of full payment only the successful buyer shall take the vehicle from the University campus.
10. The buyer shall indemnify the University from all liabilities arising thereafter.
