Astra Literati: Journal of Literary Studies is an annual journal of the Department of English Literature, School of Literary Studies, The English and Foreign Languages University, Hyderabad. Its primary objective is to explore the discipline of English Literature through a diverse variety of voices, methodologies, and perspectives.

For its inaugural issue, *Astra Literati* invites both critical and creative writings, featuring research articles, book reviews, interviews with authors, translations and poetry. We accept submissions from an array of research areas in English Literature, not limiting to period-specific studies, but extending the scope to contemporary areas of debate and discussions. We welcome contributions from both young and experienced researchers. Submissions should adhere to the journal's guidelines and be grounded in rigorous scholarship, offering fresh insights and compelling arguments.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Submissions should be original works or translations in English. All submissions should include full name, institutional affiliation, title of the paper, and an indication of the kind of contribution, i.e. research article, book review, poetry etc.

Format: Please send all submissions as MS Word files only, in 12-point Times New Roman font, with double spacing and 1 inch margin on all sides.

Referencing Style: Research articles should be accompanied by an abstract (300-350 words) with a set of 5-6 keywords. All manuscripts should adhere to the [MLA Stylesheet](#) (9th edition), and include in-text citations along with a works cited list at the end.

Word limit:

- Research articles: 3000-5000 words
- Book reviews: 1000-1500 words
- Interviews: 2500-3000 words
- Poetry: 5-6 poems



Book reviews: All book reviews should include a copy of the book's front cover, along with the title, author's name, publisher, date of publication, ISBN and number of pages. Reviews of books published within one year, will only be accepted.

Submission process: All submissions should be sent only via email to: englishliterature_journal@efluniversity.ac.in by **28th February 2025**. Each submission should be accompanied with a brief bio-note (100 words). Authors can expect initial feedback within 3-4 weeks after submission. Full length papers are reviewed and acceptance of the submitted work is communicated by **mid of April 2025**.

DECLARATION OF ORIGINAL WORK

All contributors should include a declaration of their work being original, whether critical or creative. Manuscripts submitted to *Astra Literati* should not be under consideration elsewhere. It is advisable to include a plagiarism report along with your submission. Plagiarism of any kind will result in a rejection of the writer's submission. If any AI tools have been used, the writer must acknowledge it. Translations should include a letter from the author granting permission for their translation to be published in *Astra Literati*. Upon acceptance, authors will be required to sign a copyright agreement.
