- i. Paper in refereed journals without impact factor 5 Points
- ii. Paper with impact factor less than 1 10 Points
- iii. Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 15 Points
- iv. Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 20 Points
- v. Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 25 Points
- vi. Paper with impact factor >10 30 Points

Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author.

More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors.

Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

Note:

- Paper presented, if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor. Supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.
- *For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories under [5 (b)] Policy Document and under [6] Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.
- The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
