Registrations for courses in the Schools of *Literary Studies, English Language Education, Language Sciences, and Interdisciplinary Studies*

Hyderabad Campus

Instructions from the Office

- i) Registrations for courses for MA Semester I will be from 2 pm on 18 Oct to 6.00 pm 21 Oct 2021. Students should request for a copy of the form before submitting the response. Students can add or delete the course only through the receipt of the form.
- ii) Class size will **not be more than 30 students**.
- iii) The timetables and course descriptions are uploaded on the University website.
- iv) The add/delete option will be available from 10 am on 22 Oct to 6.00 pm on 29 Oct 2021. Last date for finalising the courses is 29 Oct 2021.
- v) The link to add/drop courses will be deactivated after 6.00 pm on 29 Oct 2021.
- vi) Students will not be able to add or drop a course **after the deadline**.

MA Literatures in English

Instructions for registration

Students admitted to MA Literatures in English have to register for two core courses offered by the Dept of IWL this semester (IWL-C001: Postcolonialism: Theory and Practice and IWL-C002: Twentieth- Century European Fiction in Translation). Students from other MA Programmes in the School of Literary Studies, MA English (Cafeteria) and other Schools can also choose the courses offered by Dept of IWL. A student can choose a maximum of five and a minimum of three courses each semester. Class size will not be more than 30 students.

MA English Literature

Instructions for registration

Students admitted to MA English Literature have to register for the required number of core courses offered by the Dept of English Literature this semester. Students from other MA Programmes in School of Literary Studies, MA English Cafeteria and other Schools can also choose courses offered by Dept. of English Literature. A student can choose a maximum of five and a minimum of three courses each semester. Class size will not be more than 30 students.

MA Comparative Literature

Instructions for Registration

Students of MA in Comparative Literature Semester I will have to take three compulsory courses this semester, viz. CL 101 (Comparative Literature Theory and Method) and CL105 (Indian Literary Traditions I) and CL 110(Comparative Poetics). Besides this, two Optional courses are being offered by the department, viz .Narrating the Nation and Paninian Grammar I.All these courses are open to students from other MA Programmes in School of Literary Studies, MA Cafeteria and other Schools. A student can choose a maximum of five and a minimum of three courses each semester.

M.A. JMC

Instructions for Registration

All students admitted to the M.A. JMC programme will be enrolled in three compulsory core courses this semester: *JMC101 Theories of Communication*, *JMC102 News Reporting* and *JMC104 History of Media*.

In addition, they may choose to register for any of the two elective courses offered by the Department of Communication *JMC103 Media and Society*, and *JMC109 Introduction to Communication*.

They may also register for courses offered by any other programme as part of their electives.

Students from other programmes can register for any of the abovementioned five courses offered by the Department of Communication.

All students should be enrolled in a minimum of three and a maximum of five courses each semester.

M.A. Linguistics

Instructions for Registration:

All students in the M.A. Linguistics programme will be enrolled in three compulsory core courses this semester (*LS 111: Phonetics I, LS 131: Morphology I, and LS 141: Syntax I*). In addition, they may choose to register for any of the following Language Science courses offered by the School of Language Sciences (*LS 101: Language and Society; LS 107: Introduction to Panini's Grammar and Indian Logic I, LS 171: Introduction to Mathematical Linguistics, LS 181: Natural Language Processing I*). They may also register for one course offered by any other programme as part of their electives (students of MA Linguistics are allowed one elective outside the School of Language Sciences in the two-year program, so taking an elective outside the School this semester will exhaust their quota).

All students should be enrolled in a minimum of three and a maximum of five courses each semester.

M.A. English Language Teaching (ELT)

Instructions for Registration:

- All MA ELT students have to do **three compulsory courses** – **ELE 111, ELE 121, and ELE 122** in the first semester of the MA ELT programme. Each course is for **five** credits. You do not need to register for these three courses.
- In addition to the three compulsory courses, you need to choose a **fourth elective course** from the MA TESL timetable, semester one courses - **ELE 131, ELE 232 and ELE 2313**.
- You need to do a minimum of **four** courses worth **20 credits** in the **first semester**.
- You can also opt for a **fifth** course in this semester. In case you want to do so, you can pick another course from the MA TESL timetable (refer to the list above). This will make you collect a total of **25 credits** in semester one.
Ensure that the class timings of the elective courses do not clash with the

timing of any of the compulsory courses of the MA ELT programme on offer for this semester.

- You have to **register online** for the elective course(s).

M.A. English Cafeteria

Instructions for Registration:

All students of M.A. English Cafeteria programme are required to do a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 courses this semester. Please make sure that you have referred to the timetables and course descriptions before you complete the registration form in order to avoid clashes with other courses. You are advised to use your discretion in the choice of Core and Elective courses as this will have a bearing on the MA degree you wish to graduate with. With regard to the core and elective courses offered by various Schools and Departments, please refer to the timetables, which have been uploaded on our University website.

MA Computational Linguistics

Instructions for registration

Dear student, please go through the time table and the course descriptions before you register for the courses. Please remember you can submit the form only once. Once you submit your form, you will receive a copy of the form in your email. Please keep it as a record of options. It will be useful while adding/deleting a course. Please do not choose more than five courses in all.

You have to register for a **minimum of four courses**. One course from Module 1(LS 171), two courses from Module 2 (LS 131 and LS 141), and Module 3(LS 181) are available. **You need to register LS 171, LS 131, LS 141 and LS 181 compulsorily**. In addition, LS 107 is available under the “Other” option and LS 101 and LS 111 in case you want to register for more than four courses.

Remember that you need to fulfill 20 credits from Module 1, 20 credits from Module 2 and 20 credits from Module 3 to get an MACL degree. In addition, you

have to do either an internship or project for 5 credits and any other course for 5 credits.
