Submissions

All submissions (in PDF and Doc format) must be made through the Journal's address <u>efljournaleditor languages@efluniversity.ac.in</u>. All manuscripts submitted to the Journal must be original and free of plagiarism. The Journal does not consider manuscripts that have been previously published in any format (including other languages). All articles are published free

of charge. Please note that AI should not be used to artificially generate core research data or conclusions, and if used, should be confined to reference management and language enhancement.

Articles must be around 4000-6500 words in length (including abstract, key words and references) and submitted along with (i) a 150-200 word Abstract, and (ii) a list of 5-8 keywords. The submissions should be double-spaced in Times New Roman 12-point font, with numbered sections and follow the APA 7th edition referencing style.

The following is the order of the manuscript:

Sheet 1: Title of the article

Sheet 2: Title of the article (repeated); Abstract, keywords, text, notes, acknowledgement, appendices and references

Last sheet: Author's name, affiliation, email, phone number and address for correspondence.
